



Instructions:

Simulate your selection for each of the five sets by using the method described for set.

You should end up with five selections, and will need to mark each of these as correct or incorrect (use the powerpoint page displayed).

<p>Set 1 Use the spinner to select a person.</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div> <p>Set 2 Shuffle up the cards into a random order, and then take the first card as the person you have selected.</p> <p>Set 3 Put the four paperclips into the envelope, shake, and then select one at random. If you get a pink paperclip, this means you selected the person.</p>	<p>Set 4 Use the spinner to select a number. If you get a "1", then this means you got the correct sibling.</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div> <p>Set 5 Generate a random number between 1 to 4 on your calculator/spreadsheet. If you get a 1 then this means you got the correct sibling.</p>
